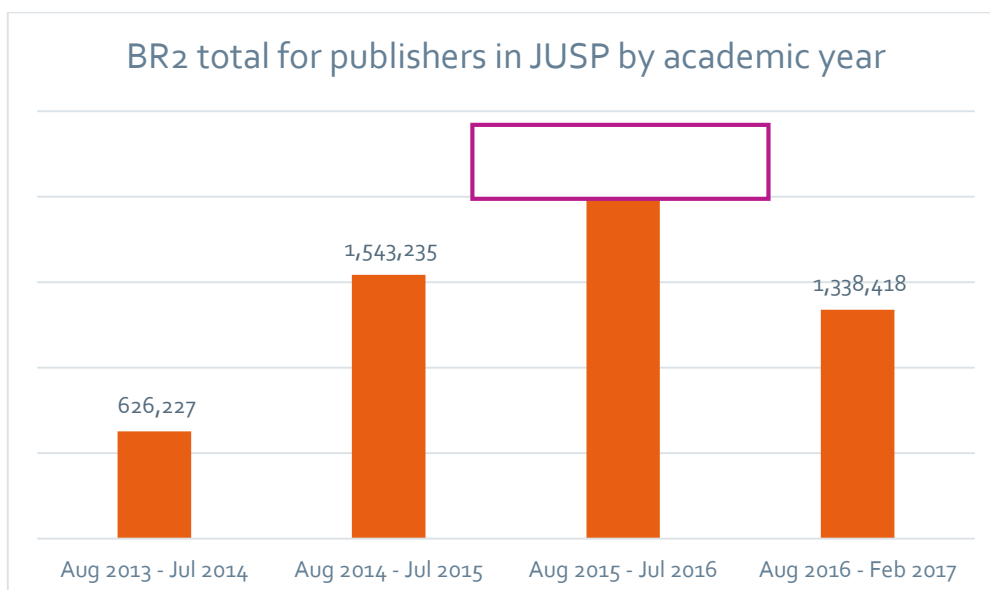


# JUSP workshop - books

4. Run the SCONUL returns report. Which publisher has the highest usage count in the academic year 2016/17 so far?
5. Run last year's SCONUL return and use the information to complete the chart below.
