Publisher Priority Survey 2013



The Publisher Priority Survey ran from 26 February to 18 March and received 41 replies from 41 different institutions.

Respondents were asked to give up to 10 publisher priorities in ranked order for future inclusion in JUSP. In total, 87 publishers were suggested. The table below lists the 22 publishers that were mentioned four times or more

The EBSCO databases received the largest number of votes, with 13 of the 18 mentions putting them as first priority, followed closely by the Proquest databases.

These titles were in the Bepress NESLi2 deal in 2012 so it would be helpful to have this publisher too

for comparison purposes.

Comments

There was recognition of what JUSP had already achieved:

All the more awkward publishers have already been JUSPed (thank you!)

Thank you for all of your work on JUSP

And on ongoing work to get in more publishers:

Priorities include some which you are currently seeking agreement on. We are also keen to have Emerald available - but haven't included it on the list since it looks from the info on the web site that this is in progress.

There were also requests (as in the previous survey) to include all publishers on a particular platform:

Would you consider collecting data from platforms? We have real trouble collecting our statistics on Highwire and Ingenta mostly with missing publishers or titles and have to constantly waste time chasing these up. It would be great if you would consider this

Everything from Scitation would be greatly appreciated

Also to consider e-books:

I realise that JUSP was originally set up to cater for journal usage reports. However, I wonder if there might be scope for including usage reports for books as well. I understand that there may well be very good reasons why this wouldn't be appropriate though thought it might be worth raising..

And databases:

Although the above lean more towards databases than journals any pressure that can be put on them to start using standardised reports would be most welcome.
